
## **Food**

## The Camp Options

Below, are the various options and costs associated with the Pillsbury College Prep English Language Camp – and be put on a path toward attending an American university of their choosing.

## **Camper Ages & Camp Options:**

For students ages 11 – 18 (two week, three week, or four week options)

Two-Week Camp Fee: \$3,500 USD Three-Week Camp Fee: \$4,800 USD Four Week Camp Fee: \$5.900 USD

Dates: 6/23/24 to 7/2/24 and 7/24/24 to 8/18/24

**Camp Fee Includes**: room, meals, all curriculum, transportation (while attending camp), transfer to/from airport, workbooks/ course materials, extracurricular activities at Camp Pillsbury, and all camp-wide noted trips, camp health insurance, two college visits, college counseling, SAT/ACT practice exam(s). Camp does not include: 1:1 tutoring, off-site food, personal electronics

Students must provide: two forms of identification, laptop (Microsoft Suite installed) with charger, laptop case, personal cell phone, 7 days of clothing, and a backpack.
